| <p>2) Election Surveys (<u>pre-election period or the election period</u>) (NPO or registered charity)</p> | <p>Surveys about voting, or about an issue with which a registered party or candidate is associated, that a third party conducts or causes to be conducted during the pre-election period* or the election period.** The survey results are used in deciding whether or not to organize and carry out regulated activities, or in the organization and carrying out of regulated activities. [highlight for registered charity]</p> |
| <p>3) Partisan Advertising (only <u>pre-election period</u>) (NPO only)</p> | <p>The transmission to the public by any means during the pre-election period of an advertising message that promotes or opposes a political party, nomination contestant, candidate or party leader, other than by taking a position on an issue with which the party or candidate is associated.</p> |
| <p>4) Election Advertising (only <u>election period</u>) (NPO or registered charity)</p> | <p>The transmission to the public by any means during the election period of an advertising message that promotes or opposes a registered party or candidate, including by taking a position on an issue with which the party or candidate is associated. [highlight for registered charity]</p> |
